Our Vision 2025 Strategic Plan drives everything we do to increase investment and reduce poverty in five Memphis zip codes by focusing on what families need most: opportunity, support, and access.

Through this place-based approach, we're strengthening economic mobility, growing collaborative partnerships, and bringing proven models to more neighborhoods across our city.

This year alone, WFGM will invest \$1.8 million in grant funding to 38 local nonprofit partners providing programs in five key areas:

- Case management and wraparound support
- Early childhood development
- Youth development and employment
- Adult education, training, and entrepreneurship
- Financial education and asset building

In the first four years of Vision 2025, more than 34,000 individuals have been served through our collective efforts—thanks to donors like you.
